BACKGROUND

- The Administrative Code Enforcement Program was adopted by the City Council on July 13, 1999, establishing a means for cost recovery for Code Enforcement processes.
- 2. The City is required to conduct a public hearing on the costs.
- 3. Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Press Enterprise on June 25, 2019.

CODE ENFORCEMENT STATISTICS

- 1. For Fiscal Year 2019-20, the Code Enforcement Division has processed approximately 10,516 cases.
- 2. The total number of properties with uncollected administrative and abatement costs, under consideration today is 66 properties, approximately .63% of all cases.
