## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 22451 KNOWN AS THE MASTER PARKING SCHEDULE RESOLUTION TO REMOVE THE PREFERENTIAL PARKING ZONE ON CARNATION COURT.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department received a petition from 85% of the residents living on Carnation Court requesting the removal of the existing Preferential Parking Zone ("PPZ"); and

WHEREAS, the residents indicate that the PPZ was implemented years ago to address an overflow parking issue that no longer exists; and

WHEREAS, the removal of the PPZ would provide unrestricted on-street parking opportunities for residents and their guests; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2019, the Transportation Board approved staff's recommendation the remove the "2-Hour Parking Between the Hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. of any day except Saturday, Sunday and holidays with Preferential Parking Permits for residents" zone on the entire street of Carnation Court. The resident petition and Transportation Board report requesting removal of the PPZ were prepared based upon the existing posted PPZ signage however, the formally adopted restriction which requires removal is "1-Hour Parking Between the Hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. of any day except Saturday, Sunday and holidays with Preferential Parking Permits for residents" on the entire street of Carnation Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That the Master Parking Schedule is hereby amended by removing the existing "1-Hour Parking Between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. of any day except Saturday, Sunday and holidays with Preferential Parking Permits for residents" on the entire street of Carnation Court.

1	Section 3: That the provisions of this resolution shall be operative only when signs are
2	erected on that portion of the street set forth in Section 2 above, giving notice of the parking
3	limitations or prohibitions herein established.
4	Section 4: The provisions of this amendment shall be operative as of the date of adoption
