- 1. Riverside County's Department of Animal Services has provided animal control field, shelter and intermittent licensing services to the City since 1995.
- 2. Together, both agencies work to promote animal welfare, public health and safety, and quality of life within the City of Riverside.

DISCUSSION

The proposed agreement will:

- 1. Approve a retroactive term of July 2018 Dec 2020 (previously were on a month-to-month basis); and
- 2. Maintain same levels of service and compensation currently in effect (no increased cost to the City).

Note: During the next year, City and County staff will negotiate a new longer term agreement which will be brought before City Council for approval.

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council:

- 1. Approve the Agreement for Animal Control Field and Licensing Services with the County of Riverside in the amount of \$2,201,718 through December 31, 2020; and
- 2. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the Agreement for Animal Control Field Services and Licensing with the County of Riverside, Department of Animal Services for a term retroactive to July 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020, including making minor and non-substantive changes.
