ISSUE:

Receive a report and provide feedback on the City of Riverside 2019 Community Quality of Life Survey.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council receive a report and provide feedback on the City of Riverside 2019 Community Quality of Life Survey.

DISCUSSION:

In 2013 and 2016, the City of Riverside contracted with the Institute of Applied Research and Policy Analysis (IAR) at California State University San Bernardino to conduct the Community Quality of Life Survey. This survey provides an opportunity for the City to measure its progress toward enhancing Riverside’s quality of life and serves as a springboard for community-wide engagement and action geared toward improving quality of life in the City.

Today’s presentation by Dr. Barbara Sirotnik, Director of the Institute of Applied Research, will provide an overview of the 2019 Community Quality of Life Survey questions and methodology and discuss the actionable data from the survey results.
