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Types of Disasters

- Natural (e.g., earthquakes, wildfires, extreme heat, winter storms)
- Technological (e. g., hazardous material spill, utilities outage)
- Man-Made (e.g., terrorism, mass shooting, cyber attack)







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Emergency Preparedness

- Following a major disaster Emergency Response won't be available immediately
- Plan on family being self-reliant for at least 7 to 10 days maybe more





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Financial Preparedness

Have a Financial Preparedness Kit

- Household Identification
- Financial and Legal Documentation
- Medical Information
- Household Contacts





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Disaster Supplies

- Food & Water
- Batteries
- · First Aid Kit
- Extra prescription medication
- Nonprescription Drugs
- Tools and Supplies
- Copies of Important Documents
- Cash (small bills) & coins
- Sanitation
- Clothing, Blankets or sleeping bags
- Extra Eye Glasses & Sunglasses
- Special needs walker/cane
- Pets -food, toys, and a picture of your pet
