## **DISCUSSION:**

RPD Complaint Policy 1009, 1009.18(a)(b) CPRC Evaluation of Complaint Procedure Compliance includes CPRC conducting a biannual audit of random police complaint cases for compliance and timeliness. Chair Ortiz and Vice Chair Evans audited 30% of the new cases. Attached are the audit worksheets. There were no concerns or findings in this audit.
