



THIRD AMENDMENT TO MASTER AGREEMENTS FOR WATER DIVISION CONTRACTOR'S PAVING PANEL FOR A THREE-YEAR EXTENSION

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BACKGROUND

1. Water Pipeline replacement projects require pavement restoration
2. Water Pipeline contractors perform trench repaving as part of project's scope of work
3. RPU Water Construction crews do not have means to repave pipeline trenches



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BACKGROUND (CONT.)

4. Public Works pavement crews have been able to perform trench repaving
 - a. Becoming busy with other projects
 - b. Difficult to schedule the work
5. An alternative means to execute paving projects is needed
6. November 19, 2010 – RPU Board recommended that City Council establish the Water Division's Contractor's Paving Panel



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BACKGROUND (CONT.)

7. December 7, 2010 – Council approved Contractor's Paving Panel
8. November 1, 2013 – RPU Board approved First Amendment for a three-year extension through October 23, 2016
9. September 26, 2016 – RPU Board approved Second Amendment for a three-year extension through October 23, 2019



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BACKGROUND (CONT.)

10. July 11, 2017 – Council adopted a resolution clarifying certain aspects of the Contractor's Paving Panel

11. Contractors on the Panel:

- a. All American Asphalt
- b. Hardy & Harper, Inc.
- c. R.J. Noble Company
- d. Ben's Asphalt and Maintenance Co., Inc. dba Medina Construction



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BACKGROUND (CONT.)

12. Contractor's Paving Panel is used when PW staff is not available (workload)

13. RPU Board approves expenditures over \$50,000

14. Staff prepares construction documents, Purchasing Manager invites Contractor Paving Panel to submit bids, then awards to the lowest panel bidder



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RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of Public Utilities approve the Third Amendment to Master Agreements for the Water Division Contractor's Paving Panel with All American Asphalt, of Corona, CA, Hardy and Harper, Inc., of Santa Ana, CA, R.J. Noble Co., of Orange, CA, and Medina Construction, of Riverside, CA, for a three-year extension.



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
