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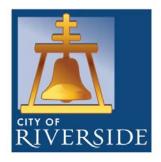
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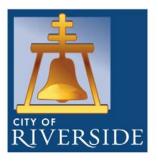

PLANNING CASE P19-0016 – CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT – INTERNET CAFÉ – 1201 UNIVERSITY AVENUE, WARD 2 Proposal by Aaron Holder, on behalf of Burnham Nationwide, to consider a Conditional Use Permit to permit an internet café ("Phantom X eSports"). Veronica Hernandez, Associate Planner, presented the staff report. Aaron Holder, on behalf of the applicant, stated they were in agreement with the recommended conditions. There were no comments from the audience. The public hearing was closed. Following discussion the Planning Commission recommended that the City Council: 1) Determine that the proposed project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant Section 15301, (Existing Facilities) of the CEQA Guidelines, as the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment; and 2) Recommend adoption of the mitigation monitoring or reporting program pursuant to CEQA Section 21081.6; and 3) Planning Case P19-0016 (Conditional Use Permit), based on the findings outlined in the staff report and subject to the recommended conditions.		x		x	x	X	X	×	X	x
