

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR  
4 GRANT FUNDS FOR CALIFORNIA CLIMATE INVESTMENTS URBAN  
5 GREENING PROGRAM

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for  
7 the program shown above; and

8 WHEREAS, the California Natural Resources Agency has been delegated the responsibility  
9 for the administration of this grant program, establishing necessary procedures; and

10 WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California Natural Resources Agency require  
11 a resolution certifying the approval of application(s) by the Applicants governing board before  
12 submission of said application(s) to the State; and

13 WHEREAS, the applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of  
14 California to carry out the Project.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,  
16 California, as follows:

17 Section 1: Approves the filing of an application for the “Gage Canal Trail – Phase 1”  
18 project.

19 Section 2: Certifies that applicant understands the assurances and certification in the  
20 application.

21 Section 3: Certifies that applicant or title holder will have sufficient funds to operate and  
22 maintain the project consistent with the land tenure requirements; or will secure the resources to do  
23 so.

24 Section 4: Certifies that it will comply with the provisions of Section 1771.5 of the State  
25 Labor Code.

26 Section 5: If applicable, certifies that the project will comply with any laws and  
27 regulations including, but not limited to, legal requirements for building codes, health and safety

1 codes, disabled access laws, environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction,  
2 all applicable permits will have been obtained.

3 Section 6: Certifies that applicant will work towards the Governor's State Planning  
4 Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the environment, and promote  
5 public health and safety as included in Government Code Section 65041.1.

6 Section 7: Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, as agent to conduct all  
7 negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications,  
8 agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the  
9 aforementioned project(s).
