Primary Roles & Responsibilities



- SCAG is tasked with:
 - Developing a long-range Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), including a Sustainable Communities Strategy (SCS), to meet greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction targets.
 - Developing a short-range Transportation Improvement Program.
 - Developing a long-term Regional Growth Forecast.
 - Developing the Regional Housing Needs Assessment (RHNA).
 - Serving as a regional data and information center.



WHY?


- Long-term Vision and Investment Framework
- Federal Requirement
 - Updated every 4 years to maintain eligibility for federal funding
 - Long Range: 20+ years into the future
 - Financially-constrained: Revenues = Costs
 - Passes regional emission standards (Conformity)
- State Requirement
 - Must meet SB 375 requirements (address GHG reductions)

- Transportation knows no boundaries
- Coordinate regional projects
- Facilitates regional/local competitiveness for funding
- Integrates transportation investments and land use strategies
- Allows any federally-funded or regionally-significant projects to maintain their eligibility for federal funding

Regional Housing Needs Assessment (RHNA)



- State housing law requirement to determine regional housing needs
- 8 year planning period
- 5th cycle: 2013-2021
 6th cycle: 2021-2029
- Final allocation adoption October 2020
