PREVIOUS POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS - PRCSD RELATED HIGHLIGHTS

- Plant three rows of citrus along Victoria Avenue when new development occurs
- Designate Victoria Avenue as a linear park
- Decomposed granite trail on north side of Victoria Avenue and designate trail within the Trails Master Plan

UPDATED POLICY

- Due to citrus greening disease, new policy allows non-deciduous flowering trees similar in size and character of citrus
- Victoria Avenue is protected as a designated scenic parkway, not a linear park

UPDATED POLICY

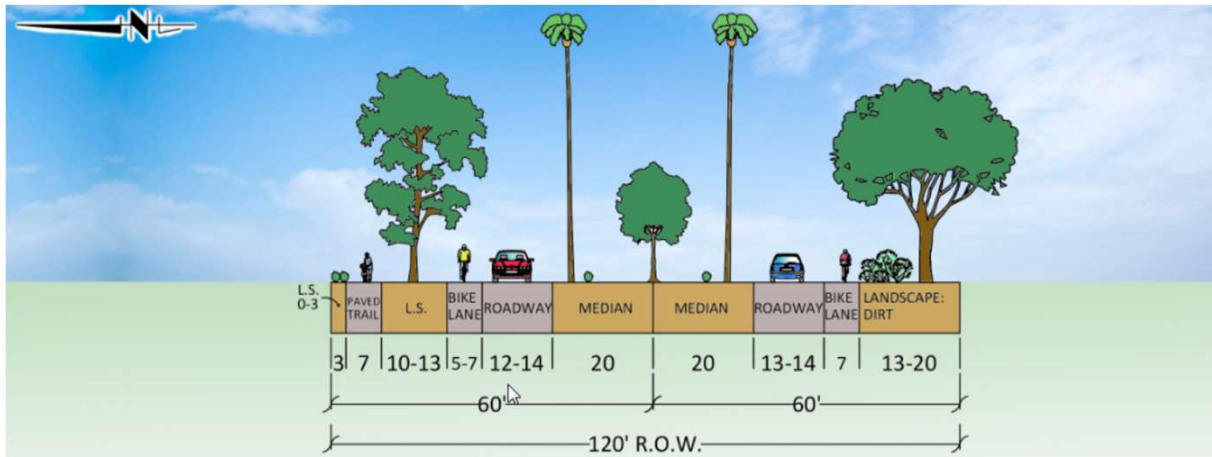
- Paved asphalt trail on the north side of the street, and decomposed granite trail on south side
- Tree maintenance and irrigation, per the Urban Forestry policy, allows irrigation of Victoria Avenue trees even during drought. Public Works and Victoria Avenue Forever will maintain in partnership.

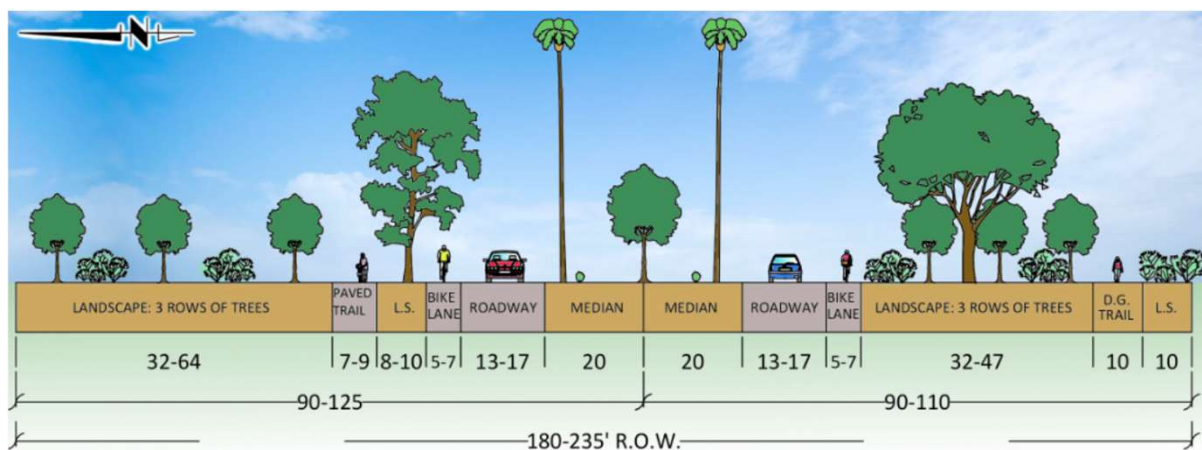
CROSS SECTION: EXISTING TYPICAL UNDEVELOPED RIGHT OF WAY CONDITION
