This letter is written on behalf of the Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians. Thank you for providing us with the Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the above referenced project. The identified location is within the Territory of the Luiseño people, and is also within Rincon's specific area of Historic interest.

We understand that the project proposes the development of a residential lot into a carwash. Record search results indicated that 47 cultural resources have been recorded within a one-mile radius, none of which located within the project site. Upon review of the MND, the information provided by the City of Riverside, and our internal records, we have concluded that the draft mitigation measures (CUL-1 through CUL-5) address Rincon's concerns pertaining to inadvertent discoveries. In addition, we understand that these measures include the following:

- 1. Provide the interested Tribes with a digital copy of the revised plans for this project,
- 2. Archaeological and Native American tribal monitoring,
- 3. Treatment and disposition of cultural resources.
- 4. Cultural sensitivity training.

We have no further concerns pertaining to potential discovery of cultural resources and human remains during ground disturbing activities for this project. We do request that a copy of the Phase IV Monitoring Report be provided to the Rincon Band upon completion.
