No person shall place, store or park any object, material or vehicle in any established exit way, driveway, gateway, alleyway, designated fire lane or any access roadway required by Section of this Code, whether of public or private property, which could hamper the egress of building occupants from or the ingress of Fire Department emergency vehicles to any occupied structure. When any such obstructions are found that might, in the opinion of the fire code official, delay or impede the egress of occupants or the ingress of Fire Department emergency vehicles, such object, material or vehicle shall be immediately removed when so order by the fire code official. When such obstacle is a vehicle and signs are posted indicating a fire lane or prohibiting parking giving notice of removal and the Police Department telephone number, the vehicle shall be immediately removed by the owner or other responsible person in charge of the vehicle or the Police Department or Fire Department may cause its removal. Section 42: The City hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15060, subdivision (c)(2) (the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment) and 15061, subdivision (b)(3) (there is no possibility the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment). In addition to the foregoing general exemptions, the City Council further finds that this ordinance is categorically exempt from review under CEQA under the Class 8 Categorical Exemption (regulatory activity to assure the protection of the environment), CEQA Guidelines section 15308.
