

 - Queuing



Least restrictive "Baseline" conditions All new permits Failure to resolve Tier 2 issues in 30 days or a significant violent incident Additional security Noise levels, hours, queuing, etc. Further violations – revocation | Further violations – revocation|



DISCUSSION – TITLE 7 (NOISE CONTROL)



Clarify and Simplify



- Improved enforcement
- Additional remedies
- Common-sense exemptions
 - Standard of reasonability



Enforcing Officers (RPD/Code):

- Determine what activities are noise disturbances
- Consider context (time of day, ambient conditions)
- Cite and fine if a violation is observed

DISCUSSION – TITLE 9 (LOUD OR UNRULY GATHERINGS)

Reduce Public Nuisance

from loud parties and social gatherings



S Prohibits admission charges, advertising (except when permitted)

Enables officers to disperse guests, issue escalating penalties

- Manage crowds
- Maintain clearances
- Respect City property
- Keep public safe



- Disperse crowds
- Relocate performers
- Issue citations
- Repeat offenses escalate penalty

- 2. Introduce and subsequently adopt the following ordinances amending the Riverside Municipal Code:
 - a. Title 5 (Business Taxes, Licenses and Regulations) adding Chapter 5.80 establishing an Entertainment Permit with corresponding regulations (Attachment 1);
 - b. Title 7 (Noise Control) clarifying and simplifying noise disturbances (Attachment 2);
 - c. Title 9 (Peace, Safety & Morals) adding Section 9.04.700 establishing rules and regulations regarding Loud or Unruly Gatherings (Attachment 3); and
 - d. Title 13 (Streets, Sidewalks, Trails and Trees) adding Chapter 13.30 establishing rules and regulations for Street Performers and amending Chapter 13.21 regarding Festival of Lights Street Performer regulations (Attachment 4); and
