## **ISSUE:**

Independent Consultant Frank Hauptmann will assist the Commission with the review of the Criminal Case Book for Officer Involved Death case for P1719632 – L. Kennon.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That the Community Police Review Commission:

1. Discuss any findings or recommendations for the Riverside Police Chief for Criminal Case Book for P17196932 – L Kennon;
2. Discuss the Commissioner Rationale Worksheets needed for Independent Consultant Frank Hauptmann's preparation of the Commission's Public Report which will be returned to the Commission for approval; and
3. Determine, or defer the vote to a future meeting, the final findings and or recommendations for the Riverside Police Chief for Criminal Case Book for P17196932 – L Kennon.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The Commission opened the review of the Criminal Case Book for an Officer Involved Death, P17196932, at the July 24, 2019 meeting and unanimously voted to continue the discussion of findings or recommendations to the August 28, 2019 meeting. The Commission discussed this case at the August 28, 2019 meeting and unanimously voted to continue the discussion of findings or recommendations to the September 25, 2019 meeting. The Commission discussed this case at the September 25, 2019 meeting and unanimously voted to continue the discussion of findings or recommendations to the October 23, 2019 meeting.
