## **OVERVIEW**


- 1. Workers' Compensation claims activities and costs from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019
- 2. Workers' Comp currently handles 600+ open claims (approximately 200 are open lifetime medical claims)
- 3. Each adjustor (currently 2) handles approximately 170 indemnity claims
- 4. Workers' Comp Assistants are currently handling a case load of 100 claims consisting of lifetime medical claims







# **LEGAL COUNSEL**

- City employs 1 legal counselor, 1 paralegal and 1 secretary with City Attorney's Office for Worker's Comp cases
- 2. Approximately 27 cases are currently with outside counsel
- 3. Legal representatives are involved in formal/informal communication and all court proceedings if injured employee obtains legal council
