SUBJECT: UPDATE ON THE 2019 FOURTH OF JULY FIREWORK DISPLAY SHOWS

## **ISSUE**:

Receive an update on the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department's Fourth of July firework display shows.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Park and Recreation Commission receive the report and presentation on the 2019 Fourth of July firework display shows and provide feedback as appropriate.

## **BACKGROUND**:

In 1996, the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department (PRCSD) hosted the first fireworks display shows at La Sierra Park and Mt. Rubidoux. Now, over 20 years later, the fireworks shows continue to draw more than 50,000 families between both locations from all over the Inland Empire.

#### **DISCUSSION**:

The fireworks display shows includes multiple departments combining their efforts for successful events. The cost of the two 2019 shows, including fireworks, fire permits, and PRCSD and Riverside Police and Riverside Fire Department personnel costs totaled approximately \$75,000.

Fireworks at Mt. Rubidoux	\$30,000
PRCSD Personnel Costs	\$12,400
Riverside Police Department	\$9,600
Riverside Fire Department	\$3,000
Total	\$75,000

Riverside Police Department assisted with traffic management at both locations. The Riverside Fire Department ensured that the pyrotechnic contractor followed fire permit laws, and assisted with making sure that Mt. Rubidoux and La Sierra Park were free from fire hazards.

The firework displays begin simultaneously at 9:00 p.m., and broadcasted through KOLA 99.9 radio station. The shows were approximately 22-25 minutes in duration.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**:

Sufficient funding in the amount of \$75,000 was included in PRCSD's FY 2019/20 Budget.
