

- Develop surveys, and create and analyze reports as an intern with the Human Resources
  Department.

Some departments may require the possession of an appropriate valid California Motor Vehicle Operator's license.

As a condition of your volunteer assignment you will be asked to successfully complete a criminal background check <u>prior</u> to your start date.




### FIND OPPORTUNITIES IN MY NEIGHBORHOOD






