2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,  
3 CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION  
4 AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT AWARD FROM THE U.S.  
5 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE  
6 CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE FISCAL  
7 YEAR 2019 URBAN AREAS SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) GRANT  
8 PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ALL REQUIRED  
9 DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER, ASSISTANT CITY  
10 MANAGER, OR FIRE CHIEF; AND AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR  
11 FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 ACCORDINGLY.

12 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (the “Grantor”), through the State of  
13 California Office of Emergency Services, has heretofore invoiced public agencies, including the City  
14 of Riverside (“City”), to submit applications to the Grantor for the Fiscal Year 2019 Urban Areas  
15 Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program (the “Grant”); and

16 WHEREAS, the City is familiar with the terms, conditions and limitations of any such Grant;  
17 and

18 WHEREAS, the City is willing and able to conform to each of the terms, conditions, and  
19 limitations imposed upon any such Grant to the City; and

20 WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for, and upon grant award, accept the grant award from  
21 the Department of Homeland Security; and

22 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the annual budget of the City to reflect and  
23 incorporate the Grant so awarded to the City, and to increase the annual appropriations and  
24 expenditures in the appropriate City program to reflect such award.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,  
26 California, as follows:

27 Section 1: The City Manager, Assistant City Manager, or Fire Chief are hereby authorized to  
28 submit a grant application for and on behalf of the City of Riverside, and is hereby authorized to  
execute all actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining federal financial assistance provided by the  
United States Department of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the State of California,  
including any extensions and amendments thereof.

Section 2: The City Council of the City of Riverside hereby agrees to, and by this resolution,  
does accept the Grant funds awarded to the City of Riverside.

Section 3: The City of Riverside hereby agrees to comply with each and all of the terms, conditions, and limitations imposed by the Grantor upon said Grant, and the City of Riverside City Manager, Assistant City Manager, or Fire Chief are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Signature Authority document attached as well as any agreements, assurance, or other documents as may be necessary in connection with acceptance and implementation of said Grant as may be required by the Grantor.
