- SUBJECT: RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULTS OF NOVEMBER 5, 2019, SPECIAL MUNICIPAL RUN-OFF ELECTION FOR WARDS 1, 3, 5 AND 7

ISSUE:

Adopt a resolution declaring the results of the November 5, 2019, Special Municipal Run-off Election to elect Members of the City Council from Wards 1, 3, 5, and 7 for five-year terms.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council adopt the attached resolution reciting the fact of the special municipal run-off election held on November 5, 2019, to elect Members of the City Council for Wards 1, 3, 5, and 7 for five-year terms and declaring the results.

BACKGROUND:

Per Elections Code Section 15372, on November 21, 2019, the Registrar of Voters will complete the canvass of returns for the Special Municipal Run-Off Election conducted on November 5, 2019. The City Attorney prepared the attached resolution to declare the results of the election. The candidates for Wards 1, 3, 5, and 7 are shown below:

<u>Ward 1</u> Erin Edwards Mike Gardner

<u>Ward 5</u> Gaby Plascencia Sean Mill <u>Ward 3</u> Warren Avery Ronaldo Fierro

<u>Ward 7</u> William D. Pearce Steve Hemenway

Preliminary results indicate Erin Edwards, Ronaldo Fierro, Gaby Plascencia, and Steve Hemenway were elected from their respective Wards for five-year terms through March 2024. Upon completion of the canvass on November 21, 2019, the Statement of Vote and resolution updated with final election results will be distributed.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Estimated charges of \$91,000 for the November 5, 2019, special municipal run-off election are included in the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Budget.
