## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, SUPPORTING AN 80-UNIT AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT TO BE LOCATED AT 11253 PIERCE STREET AND SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS BY NATIONAL COMMUNITY RENAISSANCE OF CALIFORNIA TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR DEVELOPMENT FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the State of California ("State"), through the issuance of ongoing Notices of Funding Availability, has periodically invited public agencies and not-for-profit housing developers to submit applications to fund development and services related to affordable housing and homelessness prevention including, but not limited to, No Place Like Home (NPLH) funding; and

WHEREAS, National Community Renaissance of California (National CORE), a California nonprofit corporation, is currently pursuing NPLH financing for the development and construction of an 80-unit permanent supportive housing project on property it controls located at 11253 Pierce Street in the La Sierra Neighborhood ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, in partnership with Mercy House CHDO, Inc., and Mercy House Living Centers, both California nonprofit corporations and noted social service providers, the mission of the Project would be to provide affordable housing and case management services to clients while transitioning them into permanent housing; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2018, the City of Riverside ("City") adopted a Housing First Plan which sets forth the City's policies, goals, and objectives in addressing homeless issues, through the strategic alignment of municipal and regional resources, with an emphasis on providing homeless individuals housing first and then wrap-around services; and

WHEREAS, the Project aligns with the City's Housing First Plan and would benefit the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Council hereby declares its support of National CORE's applications for State funding, the Project, and National CORE's efforts to provide stable, affordable housing and supportive services to individuals and families in the City of Riverside.
