SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE MEMBER

ISSUE:

Appoint First Alternate Monrow Mabon to the Charter Review Committee filling vacancy created by resignation of Art Angel.

RECOMMENDATION:

Mayor Bailey and Councilmember Hemenway recommend that the City Council appoint First Alternate Monrow Mabon to fill the vacancy on the Charter Review Committee.

BACKGROUND:

In August of 2018, the City Council created a fifteen-member Charter Review Committee. Each member of the City Council directly appointed one member from their respective Ward and the Mayor directly appointed two at-large members. The Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee reviewed the remaining applications and selected applicants for interview by the Mayor and City Council for six at-large positions and two alternates. Following interviews, the Mayor and City Council appointed six at-large members, a First Alternate, and a Second Alternate.

The Ward 7 direct appointee Art Angel resigned on December 9, 2019. First Alternate Monrow Mabon attended ten of the twelve Charter Review Committee meetings to date and participated in deliberations. The Committee anticipates up to four remaining meetings to conclude their work for presentation to the City Council in May 2020.


FISCAL IMPACT:
