Proposed Amendment to RMC Section 2.78.100

2.78.100 Enforcement and sanctions.

Upon a finding by a majority of the City Council that any public official violated any provision of the Prohibited Conduct section of this chapter, the City Council may impose any number of the following sanctions:

A. Elected Officials.

- 1. Public apology by the official to the complainant.
- 2. Recommendation for training.
- 3. Removal from committees.
- 4. Removal from Mayor Pro Tem rotation
- Public censure.
- 6. Restrict from traveling at public expense to attend meetings or conferences.

B. Appointed Officials

- 1. Public apology by the official to the complainant.
- 2. Recommendation for training.
- 3. Removal from Chair, Vice-chair, or other leadership positions.
- 4. Removal from the Board or Commission.
- 5. Removal from the Board or Commission and prohibition from service in the future on any City Board of Commission.
- C. No public official who is either the complainant, or the subject of a complaint, filed pursuant to this chapter shall participate in any deliberations or decision concerning any sanctions to be imposed pursuant to such complaint.
