

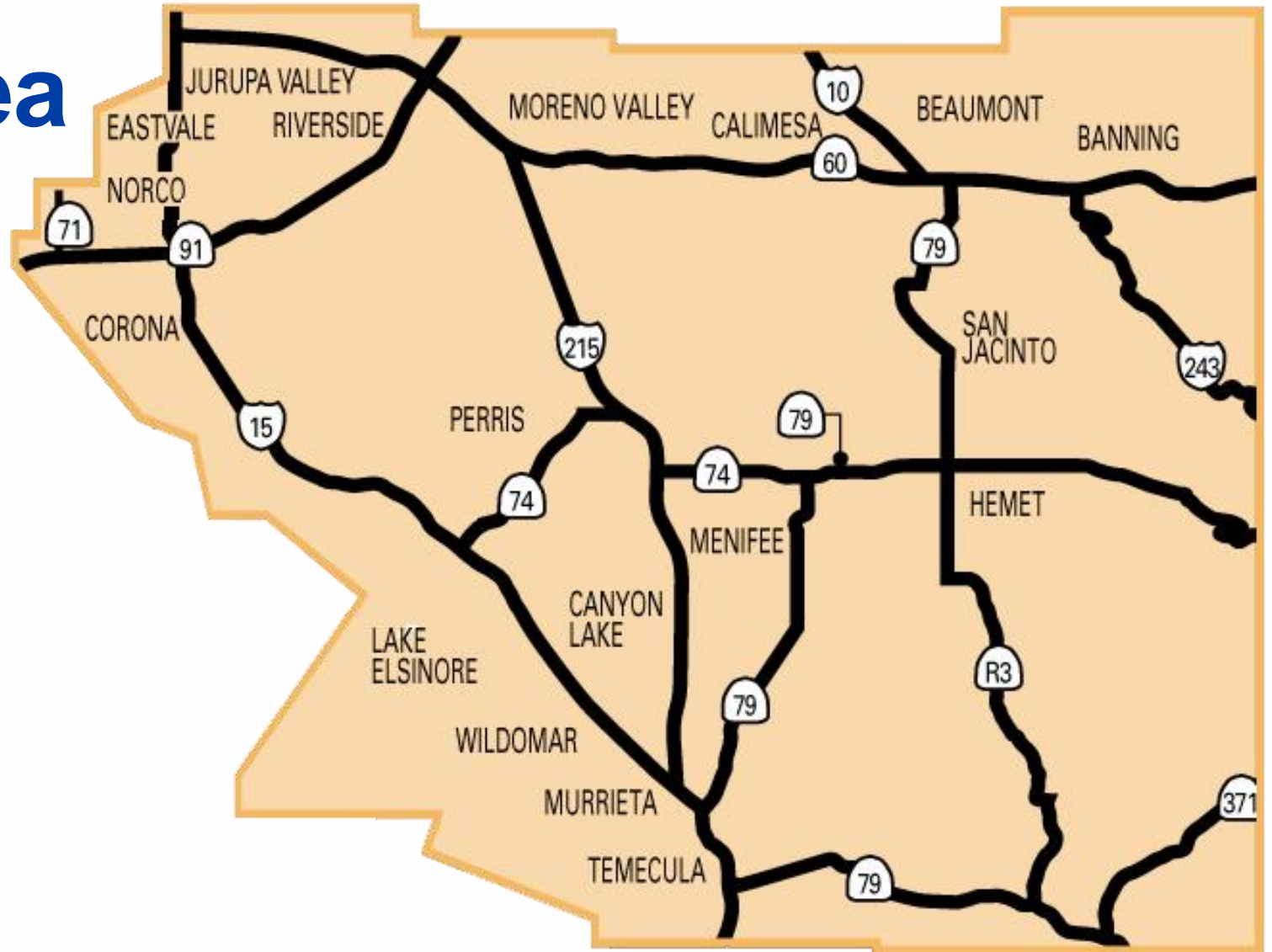

RTA Service Area

- 2,500 square mile service area
- 18 cities and four County Districts
- Fixed Route & Dial-A-Ride





Ridership – FY2019

- 8,697,649 million boardings in FY 2019
- By Service Type:
 - Local Fixed Route = 90.8%
 - CommuterLink = 4.6%
 - Dial-A-Ride = 4.6%

- Seniors (65+) & disabled
- Single city only (local)
- No application required

ADA Dial-A-Ride Service

- Persons with disabilities
- Entire service area
- Application & healthcare professional verification

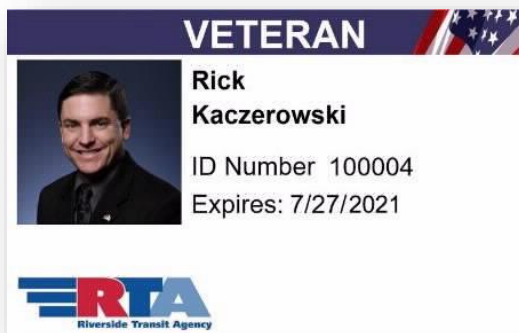

Travel Training



Senior Group Training:

- Older adults who are aging out of their driver's licenses

Veterans:

- Route familiarization for veterans and their families
- Individual training for disabled veterans

Disabled Individuals:

- Intensive one-on-one origin to destination training
- Transition-age based group instruction



Senior Group Travel Training

- Group instruction on using the fixed route bus safely and independently
- Bus familiarization and group outing connect seniors to their community through transit

Travel Training for Veterans

INDIVIDUAL TRAINING

- Designed for Veterans with disabilities
- Overcome barriers to achieve independent travel



GROUP TRAINING

- Route Familiarization
- Open to Veterans and their spouses



Individual Travel Training for People with Disabilities

- Individualized travel plan
- Learn at your own pace
- Increase independence and self-confidence
