FOURTH AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

COMPUTRONIX (U.S.A.), INC.

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Fourth Amendment"), is made and entered into this ______ day of ______, 20____ ("Effective Date"), between CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a California charter city and municipal corporation ("City"), and COMPUTRONIX (U.S.A.), INC., a Colorado corporation authorized to do business in California ("Consultant"), collectively "Parties," on the terms conditions set forth below.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on or about October 7, 2015, the Parties entered into a Professional Services Agreement ("Agreement), in the amount of \$1,307,870, for services related to Permit Tracking Software, RFP 1470 ("Project");

WHEREAS, on or about April 18, 2017, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to Professional Services Agreement ("First Amendment"), to add additional services to the Agreement and increase the amount of compensation to \$1,794,130;

WHEREAS, on or about June 11, 2018, the Parties entered into a Second Amendment to Professional Services Agreement ("Second Amendment"), to add additional services to the Agreement and increase the amount of compensation by \$76,650;

WHEREAS, on or about February 12, 2019, the Parties entered into a Third Amendment to Professional Services Agreement ("Third Amendment"), to add additional services to the Agreement and increase the amount of compensation by \$120,900; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the Agreement to add additional services, increase the compensation by an additional \$192,230 for those services, and extend the term of the Agreement through January 10, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals, which are incorporated herein by this reference, City and Consultant agree as follows:

1. The description of the services to be provided under the Agreement and Exhibit A, as amended, is further amended to add the services described in Exhibit "A-4," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

2. Paragraph 2 of the Professional Services Agreement, "Term," shall be modified to read as follows:

"2. **Term.** This Agreement shall be effective on the date first written above and shall remain in effect until January 10, 2021, unless otherwise terminated pursuant to the provisions herein."

3. Paragraph 3 of the Professional Services Agreement, "Compensation/Payment," shall be modified to read as follows:

"3. **Compensation/Payment**. Consultant shall perform the Services under this Agreement for the total sum of Two Million One Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand Nine Hundred Ten Dollars (\$2,183,910), payable in accordance with the terms set forth in Exhibit "B." Said payment shall be made in accordance with City's usual accounting procedures upon receipt and approval of an itemized invoice setting forth the services performed. The invoices shall be delivered to City at the address set forth in Section 4 hereof.

The previously agreed upon rate of \$150 per hour for professional services shall remain valid through the completion of all work associated with this Fourth Amendment. Future professional services for work beyond the currently amended Scope of Work described herein shall be billed at the rate of \$165 per hour."

4. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement between the parties which are not inconsistent with the terms of this Fourth Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein.

For POSSE LMS Administration support, the scope of services will consist of:

- Supporting Riverside in defining and creating configuration metadata (inclusive of conditions, reviews, referrals, inspections, checklist and fees) in the POSSE LMS administrator interface based on Riverside defined guidelines for Job workflows and fees.
- For requested enhancements the scope of services will consist of:
 - Gathering and validation of enhancement requirements, analysis and design, POSSE construction/configuration, quality assurance activities, installations, and UAT and production support.

All related Computronix time spent on supporting metadata configuration and requested enhancements will be covered under this Change Request.

- Time will be consumed for planning, design, updates and changes, including preparation meetings and discussions with the client, along with project management participation will be covered under this change request.
- Applies to applicable Permit Jobs for Planning, Fire Prevention and Public Works. Applies to applicable Planning Jobs for Public Works and Planning.
- Mentoring (e.g. advising on ways to use LMS to meet business needs, advising if a particular client idea would produce the desired outcome, advising on how to set up admin data or recommendations regarding ensuring new client initiatives are successful).
- System Meetings, project administration and delivery activities related to these professional services hours.
- Meetings, project administration and delivery activities related to these professional services hours.

General Project Assumptions:

- All work performed by Computronix is assumed to be remote where meetings are held via web or audio conference.
- Computronix will utilize a fixed role rate at \$150/hr. for all work effort tied to the scope of work identified within this Document.
- Computronix will provide Riverside support with Metadata setup, enhancements, and other Mentoring
 requests up to the hours limit of this CR (800 hours). Any additional support will require other funding
 sources.

CLIENT Responsibilities

- The City will be responsible for selecting and scheduling designated staff resources and for ensuring that staff are freed up from other job responsibilities in order to provide input on various elements of meta-data set-up utilized for applicable Jobs related to Phase II Implementation Effort.
- The City will be responsible for selecting and scheduling designated Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) to participate in development, review and approval of meta-data.

the application. Participants have plenty of time to practice each concept, and then tie the concepts together through some larger projects.

Participants can expect to be introduced to the important concepts of Winchester configuration through this course; proficiency will take extra experience and mentoring.

O OUTRIDER CONFIGURATION (FAST TRACK) [3 DAYS (20 HOURS OF INSTRUCTION TIME)]

MAXIMUM OF 8 STUDENTS.

This course is only available to participants who are already familiar with configuration using Stage and have already developed solutions in POSSE Client/Server, Outrider or Winchester. A brief overview of POSSE configuration fundamentals such as jobs, processes, workflow and relationships is provided. Participants focus on configuring Outrider presentations to allow end users to interact with the application. Participants have plenty of time to practice each concept, and then the the concepts together through some larger projects.

Participants can expect to be introduced to the important concepts of Outrider configuration through this course; proficiency will take extra experience and mentoring. Outrider configuration is more complicated than Winchester configuration. Outrider also allows for much more customization. The most frequently used Outrider customizations will be covered during the course.

O PL/SQL AND POSSE [1 DAY (6.5 HOURS OF INSTRUCTION TIME)] (OPTIONAL)

MAXIMUM OF 8 STUDENTS.

This course is only available to participants who have some programming experience with any language and have already configured solutions in Outrider or Winchester. This course covers PL/SQL basics, POSSE Database APIs and the events that allow PL/SQL code to run.

By the end of the course, participants will know how to tie PL/SQL scripts into their configured solution using Stage and will have practiced writing PL/SQL code and testing it in Winchester

• POSSE 7 SUPPORT [3 DAYS (20 HOURS OF INSTRUCTION TIME)]

MAXIMUM OF 8 STUDENTS.

Training involves expansive use of POSSE Stage along with database procedures, Marshal use and functionality and application to database upgrades and environments.

POSSE AD-HOC REPORTING AND WORD MERGE FUNCTIONALITY [1.5 DAYS (10 HOURS OF INSTRUCTION TIME)] (OPTIONAL)

MAXIMUM OF 8 STUDENTS.

This course can be taken by participants who have a general understanding of feature sets in the POSSE LMS application, including general criteria associated with the POSSE Data Warehouse component (known as CORRAL). The course includes the ability for a student to create, generate, modify and incorporate various reporting functionalities within the Ad-hoc Tool. Students will learn how to apply data from POSSE into various types of report outputs. Separately, but included with this training, students can also learn an in-depth

understanding of Word Merge Functionality as it applies to POSSE LMS, including Word Macro set-up, template use, application and attributes related to the Administrative Web Console set-up.

O XTRA REPORTS [1.5 DAYS (10 HOURS OF INSTRUCTION TIME)] (OPTIONAL)

MAXIMUM OF 8 STUDENTS.

Training involves learning the Xtra Reports tool and integrating Xtra Reports into POSSE. Students will learn enhanced layout designer with Xtra Reports layout tools; Improved report generation performance; additional reporting capabilities; and simplified report creation.

All related Computronix time spent on enablement training services will be covered under this Change Request.

- Time will be consumed for preparation, delivery, response and follow-up (see below) of specific training courses for the client, along with project management participation. All costs identified for this effort have been included in this Change Request.
- Mentoring (e.g. advising on ways to further expand capability of tools and techniques identified from each training course) has been identified as part of this effort. Computronix recommends that an additional budget line item be incorporated for follow-up and support of course learning. All mentoring is expected to be performed remotely.
- o Project administration and training activities related to these professional services hours.

General Project Assumptions:

All training will be provided by Computronix Staff at the City of Riverside CA.

The City will be responsible for reimbursement to Computronix for all actual travel related costs to bring the Computronix Trainer(s) to Riverside offices.

Courses may be consumed individually or collectively. Courses can be a full business week (5 days) or as little as one (1) day.

The City will provide notice to Computronix for scheduling purposes. Notice must be provided at least three (3) weeks in advance of any training on-site at Riverside.

A soft copy of the training materials for each course will be provided by Computronix.

As the training will be conducted at the Riverside CA offices, Riverside will be responsible for the following:

- City will supply the Training environment allowing remote desk top sessions to servers set up by Computronix.
- The City will be responsible for selecting and scheduling designated staff resources to be trained and for ensuring that staff attend any in-class training sessions. A list of staff scheduled to attend shall be provided to Computronix at least one (1) week, prior to on-site engagement at the City.

Phase 2 on-site Self-Enablement training assumes 4 on-site trips. Riverside can arrange the training courses as desired within prerequisites of the courses and that fit into the training weeks. If more than 4 training trips will be requested by Riverside the additional trip(s) will need to be funded other from this CR. The 4 trips are assumed to be as follows:

o 1 – 5-day trip -Winchester Training



Riverside PTS Project Change Request 1 – 4 day trip – Outrider Training 0 2 - 3 day trips (the balance of the classes) 0 The Training Manual(s) and Agenda will be forwarded in electronic form to allow hard copies to be printed for Trainees one week prior to the class. The City will be responsible for providing writing materials (paper, pencil/pen, etc.) as part of notes applicable to each course taken by a student. The maximum number of students shall not exceed the number listed by class type. The assumption is that enablement activities in the City's development environment will not begin until after all warranty periods have expired. Should the work begin sooner, a new process for coordination of activities, code moves into production, synchronization of code bases, and issue triage will need to be documented and agreed to as a separate effort. For training continuity, it is recommended that all training be accomplished within a 6-week period. This prices for the classes are valid until December 31, 2020. If classes are not completed by this date the quoted class prices expire and will need to be re-evaluated and a new quote provided. **CLIENT Responsibilities** The City will be responsible for selecting designated staff resources and for ensuring that staff are readily available to participate in training courses offered by Computronix. Individuals participating in these courses will have some previous experience with programming languages (as identified above) and will have strong capabilities in utilize the various POSSE software applications associated with training services.
