**SUBJECT: DONATION OF DOG ART PIECE ENTITLED "GAME ON" BY ANNA VANOVER
FROM PHYLLIS CRABTREE VALUED AT \$500**

ISSUES:

Formally accept and recommend that the City Council authorize the acceptance of a donation of a dog art piece entitled "Game on" by Anna Vanover donated by Phyllis Crabtree of Riverside, CA valued at \$500.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Board of Library Trustees:

1. Formally accept the donation of the dog art piece entitled "Game On" by Anna Vanover donated by Phyllis Crabtree of Riverside, CA, valued at \$500; and
2. Upon acceptance, recommend that the City Council authorize acceptance of the donation to the Riverside Public Library.

BACKGROUND:

On December 2, 2019, the Library Department received notification from Phyllis Crabtree of her donation of a dog art piece entitled "Game On" by Anna Vanover to the Library.

DISCUSSION:

The art piece entitled "Game On" by Anna Vanover was sponsored by Phyllis Crabtree during the Art Bark in the Park fundraiser by the Riverside Art Alliance for the Riverside Art Museum. "Game On" is a Scottish terrier painted in a Monopoly theme.



The City of Riverside is not obligated in any funding for repairs, maintenance, use or replacement of the donation. The Library intends to display the art piece at the La Sierra Library.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact to the General Fund with accepting the donation.
