Please include the following amendment recommendations to a future meeting of the Charter Review Committee:

REDUCING CHARTER REVIEW PERIOD

<u>Issue:</u> The Charter should be amended to require a shorter period between Charter Committee reviews.

<u>Position</u>: A shorter period between Charter reviews would avoid the need to defer important amendments due to "ballot fatigue" and other matters not related to full consideration of necessary modification.

Recommendation: Amend the language of Section 1403 to require that in February every four years, the City Council shall appoint and appropriate adequate funds for a Charter Review Committee.

<u>Proposed Language</u>: "In February <u>2019</u> <u>2024</u>, and in February every <u>eight four</u> years thereafter, the City Council Shall appoint and appropriate adequate funds for a Charter Review Committee.

INCLUSIVE LANGUAGE

<u>Issue:</u> The Charter should be amended to replace a potentially exclusionary term with inclusive language.

<u>Position</u>: Use of the term "citizen" implies legal residency in the city. The terms of the Charter include all community members regardless of citizenship status. For example, Section 411 states: "Each citizen shall have the right, personally or through counsel, to present comments at any regular meeting of the Council, or a Council standing or ad hoc committee, or offer suggestions with respect to municipal affairs."

Recommendation: Amend the language of Section 1403 to require that in February every four years, the City Council shall appoint and appropriate adequate funds for a Charter Review Committee.

<u>Proposed Language for example provided</u>: "Each <u>eitizen</u> <u>community member</u> shall have the right, personally or through counsel, to present comments at any regular meeting of the Council, or a Council standing or ad hoc committee, or offer suggestions with respect to municipal affairs."
