BACKGROUND:

The Budget Engagement Commission (BEC) was formed in 2017 by the City Council's adoption of Ordinance 7363 and the subsequent addition of Chapter 2.90 – Budget Engagement Commission to the Riverside Municipal Code (Attachment 1). On May 20, 2019, the BEC adopted amended meeting rules (Attachment 2).

DISCUSSION:

Chairperson Lyell has requested that the BEC review and discuss the duties, roles, and responsibilities of the BEC. Attachment 1, Chapter 2.90 – Budget Engagement Commission to the Riverside Municipal Code defines the purpose and function of the Budget Engagement Commission.
