SUBJECT: NOMINATIONS AND ELECTION - MUSEUM OF RIVERSIDE BOARD OFFICERS

ISSUE:

Receive nominations and elect Museum of Riverside Board officers.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Museum of Riverside Board:

- 1. Receive nominations for Museum of Riverside Board officers as recommended by the Board Development Committee, and
- 2. Elect the Chair and Vice-Chair positions to begin March 1, 2020.

BACKGROUND:

The election of officers is to be conducted annually from the slate proposed by the Board Development Committee (formerly known as the Nominating Committee) or from nominations from the floor. All officers shall be elected by the Board members for a term of one year. A member may serve no more than two successive years in the same office. Terms begin March 1 or on the date in March (regular meeting).
