## **DISCUSSION CALENDAR**

### **ALLEY NORTH OF MISSION INN AVENUE – ESTABLISHMENT OF TEMPORARY 30-MINUTE PARKING ZONE**

Three residents spoke and one E-Comment was submitted opposing establishment of a temporary “30-Minute Parking At All Times” zone to encompass a single 20 foot parking space within the public right-of-way / alley located north of Mission Inn Avenue between Market Street and the Main Street pedestrian mall. Following discussion motion was made by Member Moran and seconded by Member Brown recommending that the Transportation Board deny the establishment of a temporary “30-Minute Parking At All Times” zone to encompass a single 20 foot parking space within the public right-of-way / alley located north of Mission Inn Avenue between Market Street and the Main Street pedestrian mall.

Motion carried for denial. Members Alderette and Bullock voted to approve.

### **SPEED LIMIT ZONE REVISIONS – CENTRAL AVENUE AND DAY STREET**

Following discussion motion was made by Member Bullock and seconded by Member Alderette recommending that the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council adopt an ordinance to:

1. Revise the boundaries of the 45 MPH speed limit zone on Central Avenue from “Canyon Bluff to Chicago Avenue” to “Canyon Creek Drive to Chicago Avenue”; and
2. Revise the boundaries of the 40 MPH speed limit zone on southbound Day Street from “Box Springs Road to Eucalyptus Avenue” to “northerly City limits to Eucalyptus Avenue.”

Motion carried unanimously.
