  - a) 216 Implementation tools
  - b) Reviewed by City Departments responsible for Implementation
  - c) 52 tools were correlated with City Department efforts in 2019
- 3. HCD RHNA progress, Units (proposed, entitled, permitted and final), Units by Affordability Housing Element:
  - a) 5th Cycle (2013-2021) Housing Element adopted in 2017
  - b) Mid-cycle (4 year) Housing Element adopted in 2018







### **ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORT - HOUSING SUMMARY**

- 1. 5<sup>th</sup> Cycle Regional Housing Needs Assessment (RHNA) 8,283 units (includes 4<sup>th</sup> Cycle carry-over):
  - a) Lower Income: 3,338 units
  - b) Moderate Income: 1,503 units
  - c) Above Moderate Income: 3,442 units
- 2. Permitted units reported to HCD (2017-2019) 1,346 units
- 3. City Obligation remaining 6,937 units

## **ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORT – 2019 SUMMARY**

- 1. Permitted Units 659 units:
  - a) 135 Single-Family Dwellings
  - b) 28 Accessory Dwellings Units
  - c) 496 Apartment Units
- 2. Increase from 2018 605 units
- 3. Significant increase in Accessory Dwelling Units from 2in 2018 to 28 in 2019
- 4. No lower-income housing units produced
