INTELLECTUAL DELAYS

ISSUE:

Receive a verbal presentation from Licensed Clinical Social Worker Lisa Dryan on postsecondary college programming for people with intellectual delays.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Commission on Disabilities receive a verbal presentation from Licensed Clinical Social Worker Lisa Dryan on post-secondary college programming for people with intellectual delays.

BACKGROUND:

The Commission on Disabilities' (COD) mission is to identify the needs of persons with disabilities and create a public awareness of these needs in the areas of employment, housing, transportation, media, and physical and communication accessibility. The mission also supports programs and activities that promote greater independence for people with disabilities.

DISCUSSION:

At the January 16, 2020 COD meeting, Commissioner Lewis requested that Licensed Clinical Social Worker Lisa Dryan be invited to address the Commission on Disabilities. Ms. Dryan accepted the invitation and will speak on post-secondary college programming for people with intellectual delays and working towards development of a program at the local community colleges with Chancellor Isaac and local legislators.
