SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL STANDING COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS

ISSUE:

Recommend City Council Standing Committee assignments to the City Council.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Committee consider City Council Standing Committee assignments for recommendation to the City Council.

BACKGROUND:

On March 3, 2020, the City Council requested the City Attorney to draft a resolution amending the City Council Rules of Procedure and Order of Business repurposing and renaming City Council Standing Committees. The City Council also requested the City Clerk to request each member of the City Council to provide their priorities for service for consideration by the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee.

Each Standing Committee shall be comprised of three members. Each Councilmember shall serve as Chair, Vice-Chair, and Member of three Committees, respectively. The Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee shall be comprised of the Mayor who shall serve as Chair and the members of the Governmental Affairs Committee.

The resolution further provides that to the greatest extent possible, preferences of senior Councilmembers shall be honored. The preferences of each member of the City Council are listed on the attached charts together with seniority ranking and two proposed rosters honoring those preferences to the greatest extent possible.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with assignments to City Council Standing Committees. Costs for staffing of Committees are included in the annual Budget.
