## RECOMMENDATIONS

2. Approve the two projectsidentified by staff (Housing Element Update and e-Plan submission software) as part of the grant application;

3. Upon award of the grant, authorize an increase in revenue up to the amount of $\$ 750,000$ to account number 9341700334100 and appropriate expenditures in the same amount to account number 9341700-440210; and
4. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the HCD grant applic ation including making minor, nonsubstantive changes, and to sign all documents and instruments necessary to complete the transaction, including, but not limited to agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary to complete grant funded activities.
