

#### **KEY FACTORS**


- 1. Public safety shall be the number one priority when considering reopening Mt. Rubidoux Park and Trails.
- 2. All State mandates must be adhered to by patrons including social distancing, face mask recommendations, etc.
- 3. Signage to be placed throughout the trails system informing the public of criteria/conditions for use.
- 4. If criteria is not followed, it is recommended that the park be closed once again in the interest of public safety.
- 5. Parking lots at Ryan Bonaminio Park must be opened to accommodate parking needs.
- 6. It will take a minimum of 72 hours to prepare the site for re-opening once approval is granted.

#### **OPTION A**




- 1. Split two-way lanes from Glenwood Drive entrance and 9<sup>th</sup> Street entrance to the "cross-road".
- One way circulation from "crossroad" with an "up road" and a "down road".
- 3. Strollers and pets will be discouraged.
- 4. Social Distancing signage with guidelines to help keep the trails open.
- 5. Signage to minimize unnecessary gatherings.

### **OPTION B**



- 1. Split two-way lanes from Glenwood Drive entrance and 9<sup>th</sup> Street entrance to the "cross-road".
- 2. Two-way circulation from trailheads to the top of Mt. Rubidoux.
- Strollers and pets will be discouraged.
- 4. Social Distancing Signage with guidelines to help keep the trails open.
- 5. Signage to Minimize unnecessary gatherings.
