FIRST AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT ("First Amendment") is made and entered into this day of 2020, by and between the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a California charter city and municipal corporation ("City"), and ENVIRONMENTAL LOGISTICS, INC., a California corporation ("Consultant"), with respect to the following:

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant entered into that certain Professional Consultant Services Agreement dated November 19, 2019 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City has been satisfied with Consultant's performance under the Agreement and desires to have Consultant continue providing the services referenced in that Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is set to expire on June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant would like to increase the amount of compensation to Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000), for the remainder of the term of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, incorporating the recitals set out above, the parties hereto mutually agree to the following amendment to the Agreement.

- 1. Section 3, Compensation/Payment, is hereby amended to increase the compensation in the amount of Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000).
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement between the parties, which are not inconsistent with the terms of this First Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein.
