SUBJECT: ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT OF \$359,469,181 - RESOLUTION

ISSUE:

Adopt a Resolution establishing the Fiscal Year 2020/21 Appropriations Limit of \$359,469,181 as required by Article XIIIB of the State Constitution.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council adopt a Resolution establishing the Fiscal Year 2020/21 Appropriations Limit of \$359,469,181 as required by Article XIIIB of the State Constitution.

BACKGROUND:

An annual appropriations limit established by City Council Resolution is required as a result of the 1979 Proposition 4, Gann Initiative, Article XIIIB of the State Constitution and Section 7910 of the Government Code.

DISCUSSION:

The appropriations limit for the City of Riverside is calculated to be \$359,469,181 for Fiscal Year 2020/21. Documentation showing the calculations made to arrive at the appropriations limit has been available in the Finance Department for review by the public for at least 15 days. (Attachments 2 and 3)
