- SUBJECT: OVERVIEW PRESENTATION ON PATH OF LIFE MINISTRIES HOMELESS SERVICES

ISSUE:

Receive an overview presentation on Path of Life Ministries homeless programs and services

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. Waive the notice provisions of Riverside Municipal Code Section 4.05.050(D)(1) finding that there is a need to take immediate action as the presentation is relative to the Housing Authority overview of mission projects and budget on this agenda.
- 2. That the Committee receive and file this report.

BACKGROUND:

Path of Life (POL) Ministries operates a Community Shelter at 2840 Hulen Place in Riverside and is part of the Riverside Hulen Campus, comprised of several collaborative partners addressing homelessness. POL Community Shelter is an 85-bed year-round emergency shelter and a 55 cold weather shelter program that operates December 1st to April 15th. The City has 15 dedicated outreach beds. The Cities of Corona and Jurupa Valley also have dedicated beds at the shelter along with Riverside University Health System Behavioral Health beds.

The Community Shelter Program is an emergency homeless shelter that serves adults by providing an immediate exit off the street into temporary housing along with assistance in case management, meals, hygiene, and social supports. This program provides beds to qualified single men and women with separate dormitories for each gender up to 30-60 days. Intakes are conducted Monday through Friday at 1:00pm.
