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BACKGROUND

1. The Administrative Code Enforcement Program was adopted by the City Council on July 13, 1999, establishing a means for cost recovery for Code Enforcement processes.
2. The City is required to conduct a public hearing on the costs.
3. Notice of Public Hearing was published in the Press Enterprise on June 16, 2020.

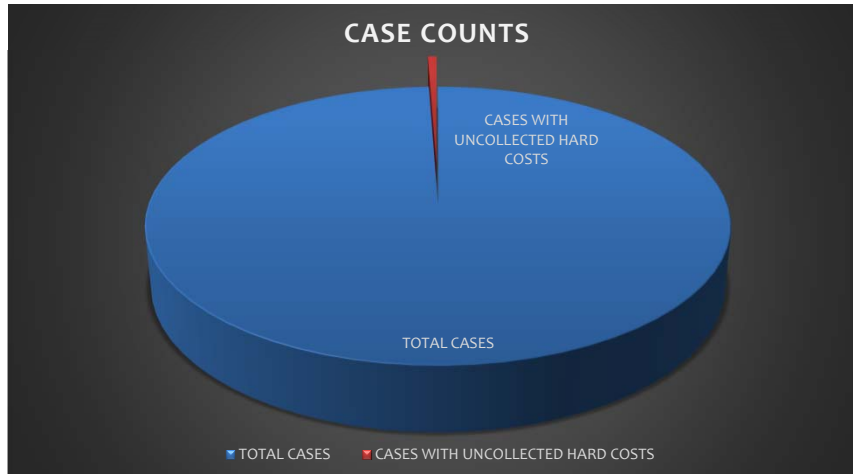


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CODE ENFORCEMENT STATISTICS
