ISSUE:

Appoint Ashton Davis to the Ward 5 seat on the Human Relations Commission.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Mayor and City Council appoint Ashton Davis to the Ward 5 seat on the Human Relations Commission for a term ending March 1, 2023.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

Councilwoman Plascencia recommends appointment of Ashton Davis to the Ward 5 seat on the Human Relations Commission for a term ending March 1, 2023, filling a vacancy created due to the resignation of James R. Rush.

Pursuant to Charter Section 802, each board and commission must have at least one representative from each of the Council Wards. This appointment will fill the vacancy with a registered voter in compliance with the Charter requirement.

Recruitment and appointment costs are included annually in the City Clerk's budget.
