

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING SECTIONS 5.38.020, 5.38.115, 5.38.130 AND 6.08.010 OF
THE RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE.

The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Section 5.38.020 of the Riverside Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

“Section 5.38.020 - General prohibitions.

A. No person shall act as a sidewalk vendor on any public street, including parkways or sidewalks, within the City, except as provided for in this chapter or otherwise permitted in the Riverside Municipal Code.

B. No person shall employ, direct or otherwise cause any person to act as a sidewalk vendor, except as provided for in this chapter or otherwise permitted in the Riverside Municipal Code.”

Section 2: Sections 5.38.115 of the Riverside Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

“Section 5.38.115 - Sidewalk Vendor location regulations.

A. No sidewalk vendor shall be located in a fixed location on any residential street, including parkways or sidewalks. Sales may be made on a residential streets from sidewalk vendor that are continually moved from place to place and stopped only for the period of time, not to exceed ten minutes at any one place, necessary to make bona fide sales to purchasers, subject to the provisions of this Code.

B. No sidewalk vendor shall be located in any location that creates an obstruction to the normal flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic or to the access to public streets and sidewalks, or that creates a hazard to life or property.

C. No sidewalk vendor shall be located in any location that obstructs traffic signals or regulatory signs.

1 D. No sidewalk vendor shall be located within 15 feet of any fire hydrant or fire escape, or
2 within 50 feet of any vehicle entrance of any fire station, police department, hospital, or any other
3 structure involved in health and safety emergency matters.

4 E. No sidewalk vendor shall be located within 15 feet of any loading zone, bus stop, or
5 parking space or access ramp designed for persons with disabilities.”

6 Section 3: Sections 5.38.130 of the Riverside Municipal Code is hereby amended as
7 follows:

8 **“Section 5.38.130 - Impoundment, abandonment, and disposal.**

9 Any unclaimed items will be considered abandoned and forfeited to the City 90 days after the
10 City calls the owner to retrieve the impounded items, and the City may destroy or otherwise dispose
11 of the impounded items pursuant to law.”

12 Section 4: Section 6.08.010 of the Riverside Municipal Code is hereby amended as
13 follows:

14 **“Section 6.08.010 - Definitions.**

15 The following definitions shall apply in the interpretation and enforcement of this chapter:

18 B. *Enforcement Officer* shall mean the Riverside County Director of the Department of
19 Environmental Health or the City of Riverside Code Enforcement Manager, and their respective
20 designees.

22 Section 5: The City Council has reviewed the matter and, based upon the facts and
23 information contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony,
24 hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2),
25 15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title
26 14, Chapter 3, in that it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change
27 in the environment nor have a significant impact on the environment.

Section 6: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the date of its adoption.
