# SUBJECT: OMNIBUS AMENDMENT TO THE RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE TO CONFORM TO THE RECENTLY RENAMED COUNCIL COMMITTEES

## ISSUE:

Adopt an ordinance amending Sections 2.78.110, 3.18.030, 5.15.145, 5.28.050, 5.32.120, 5.40.185, 5.52.050, 5.66.010, 5.66.060, 6.04.055, 9.20.200, 9.20.220, 9.40.120, 9.42.080, 16.32.170 and 20.50.010 of the Riverside Municipal Code to update those sections to reflect the recently renamed Council Committee.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That the City Council introduce and subsequently adopt the attached Ordinance amending the Riverside Municipal Code Sections 2.78.110, 3.18.030, 5.15.145, 5.28.050, 5.32.120, 5.40.185, 5.52.050, 5.66.010, 5.66.060, 6.04.055, 9.20.200, 9.20.220, 9.40.120, 9.42.080, 16.32.170 and 20.50.010.
