BACKGROUND

On September 11, 2018, the City Council:

- 1. Authorized City staff to administer the Arts and Culture Grant Program for the current two-year budget cycle in Fiscal Years 2018-2019 and 2019-2020;
- Requested the Ad Hoc Arts Grant Committee to continue to meet to address current and future art elements of advocacy, fund development, marketing and education; and
- 3. Requested the Community & Economic Development Department to collaborate with the Ad Hoc Arts Grant Committee and return to City Council for a review of process and recommendations for administration of the City's Arts and Culture Grant Program prior to Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Economic Development, Placemaking, and Branding / Marketing Committee:

- Receive an update on the administration of the Arts & Culture Grant and Emerging Artist Micro Grant Programs from Fiscal Years 2018-2019 and 2019-2020;
- 2. Authorize City staff to continue administering the Arts & Culture Grant Program in the annual amount of \$285,628 which has a City Council approved 1% annual increase in each future fiscal year;
- 3. Authorize City staff to continue administering the Emerging Artist Micro Grant Program of \$10,000 each fiscal year; and
- 4. Authorize City staff to administer both the Arts & Culture Grant and Emerging Artist Micro Grant Programs on the same cycle as the City's budget (either annual or biennial).
