ISSUE

Designate a voting delegate and alternate to represent the City of Riverside at the League of California Cities 2020 virtual annual business meeting on Friday, October 9, 2020.

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council designate Mayor Bailey as the voting delegate and Councilmember Perry as alternate for the virtual annual business meeting of the 2020 League of California Cities annual conference.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The League of California Cities (League) holds an annual conference and business meeting to take action on conference resolutions that guide cities and the League in efforts to improve the quality, responsiveness, and vitality of local government in California. The City of Riverside has the opportunity to appoint a voting delegate and alternate to represent the City of Riverside at the virtual annual business meeting on Friday, October 9, 2020.

Mayor Bailey and Councilmember Perry concur with these appointments.

FISCAL IMPACT

The conference travel and meeting expenses are included in the Mayor and City Council adopted budgets. There is no additional funding needed to designate a voting representative or to perform the duties.
