ISSUE:

Substitution of Councilmember Plascencia in place of Councilmember Hemenway on the Mobility & Infrastructure Committee for the discussion of the Van Buren Boulevard Sewer Project Update.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council appoint Councilmember Plascencia to serve in place of Councilmember Hemenway on the Mobility & Infrastructure Committee for discussion of the Van Buren Boulevard Sewer Project Update.

BACKGROUND:

On September 10, 2020, the Mobility & Infrastructure Committee will be hearing an update on the Van Buren Boulevard Sewer Project. The discussion will reference the memorandum of understanding (MOU) that allows the City to purchase the lot located on the northeasterly corner of Washington Street at Krameria Avenue from Western Municipal Water District to construct a sewer pump station to support the project. At a June 10, 2020 community meeting that discussed the Van Buren Sewer Project, Councilmember Plascencia requested to receive a project update at committee level. Councilmember Conder, chair of the Mobility & Infrastructure Committee, concurs with the requested substitution.
