RPD EVOLUTION

- 1. Since April 2000, RPD has already had investigations reviewed by CPRC
- 2. To increase independent oversight, ARCCOPS adopted a new policy effective July 1, 2020
- 3. RPD also adopted this policy

ARCCOPS POLICY PURPOSE

"The purpose of the policy is to provide consistency in interagency investigations and independent review of all peace officer involved shooting and other qualifying major incidents. This policy also establishes the expectations of the District Attorney, and the conditions of the District Attorney's Office involvement in a full and fair investigation and proper disposition of each case."

CHANGE

- To ensure full transparency, all RPD officer involved shootings and major use of force investigations will be led by an investigator from the Riverside District Attorney's Office
- 2. Ensures law enforcements agencies are not leading their own critical investigations with their own personnel

- 2. To date, Riverside PD is the only agency in Riverside County to deploy both the ARCCOPS OIS Policy and use of CPRC
- 3. Highest level of independent oversight in the region
