Hello, my name is Alexandra S Vigil and I am writing on behalf of the Vigil household. Our property is at 8537 Colorado Ave., Riverside, Ca, 92504.

We would like to protest the amount of trash services increasing, or rather that it be amended. We realize, by information provided on the notification that there are increasing needs to cover expenses somehow for recycling and other trash services. However, we believe that there should be a more closer look at the exact expenses being increased and if the raised charges are equal or more than the expenses. Also, we propose more closer monitoring of residential blue bin use with explicit explanations to residents about their role and responsibilities in helping minimize the costs of recycling by things like rinsing their recyclables, properly disposing only recyclables in blue bins, and not throwing other trash in them. Those that do not help in this matter should be ticketed and fined to cover rising costs instead of making everyone pay for their negligence. I believe this will help eliminate the laziness of many residents to take their part seriously in recycling and cover the costs of those unnecessary expenses on one hand.

Therefore this should be a two part process, 1) instilling and enforcing stricter recycling standards on residents and 2) assessing exact rise in extra costs so that any rate increases are exactly necessary and not unbeknowningly above the needs.

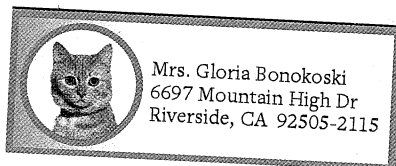



I unequivocally object to the measure rising trash or any other utility rates on the following grounds:

- 1) The notice highlights in bold that the utility increase would likely not impact tenants in multi-family housing. This is a false statement. As an underwriter of multifamily real estate transactions I can tell you with 100% certainty that this increase will be passed on to tenants and hit household balance sheets in the form of increasing rent upon lease renewal or in the form of increased utility reimbursement expenses. The rules of supply/demand and capital risk/reward are predictable and equivalent to laws of nature. Passing this increase will hit low income families and families struggling due to the economic devastation caused by government responses to COVID-19 the hardest.
- 2) The notice sent by the city confirms that the need for the city government to raise rates trash rate is caused by bigger government policy in the first place. Simply put, government is the problem and now city government is trying to be the solution. The notices claims that state mandated minimum wage increases, state mandated recycling programs, and increases to state mandated healthcare are the reasons for the increases yet our State government promised that their policies would not create inflation. Well, the fact that the city now needs to raise trash rates is proof the State lied. The proposal is to inflate our trash expenses. At what point will strong local governments like Riverside City stop bailing out failed big government, State policy?
- 3) The letter fails to mention the true budget crisis that is plaguing California and Riverside City. This is ever increasing tax payer guaranteed pension and retiree healthcare costs. Before living additional costs on citizens, the City Counsel should be forced to stand tall against Union influence. It is your moral duty to support your constituents and not just vote in favor of ever-increasing taxes and benefits to organized public labor for fear of being kicked out of office.
- 4) Before raising taxes, fees, and expenses on all city resident to benefit city employees, why not cut the pay of the highest paid city workers who make 7x or 8x more than the median household income in the city in which they live. For example:

I am opposed to the proposed trash rate increase for two reasons:

First, earlier this year City Staff presented the Council with a proposal to outsource the last remaining city-operated trash pick-up service to the current vendor who handles over 80% of the city's trash pickups. The proposal was sound, well thought out, and would have resulted in substantial savings to the city by eliminating the city's trash pick-up operations and associated positions and those city employees in that department. While it is never easy to eliminate staff, some of whom were long-term employees, in this situation the proposal required that the vendor would offer employment to the affected employees for them to work in the trash operations that would replace the city's owned operations (basically the same work but for a different employer). The Staff proposal noted that this change would create savings and either eliminate or minimize trash rate increases going forward. Despite this well thought-out proposal, the Council caved in to pressure from impacted employees and unions and voted down the proposal.

Granted it's hard to make decisions that affect employees' jobs, but the Council's responsibility is to the city at large; to work to ensure the financial health, welfare and safety of the city and its residents. And given the city's challenging financial condition, the Council should have embraced this proposal, particularly since the employees would retain work with the trash vendor.

Now, several months later, here comes Staff to the Council proposing new rate increases starting this October and recurring each year through 2024. The proposal aims to increase trash rates by 30% over the next four years from the current level. This is not only outrageous, it's shameful. The Staff and Council have shown an unwillingness to look internally for savings solutions in favor of the easiest path, once again -- put the cost on the backs of the residents and property owners in this city. The Council needs to do better. The Staff needs to do better.

Second, we are in the midst of a pandemic that has had severe economic impacts on the citizens of this community, our county, state and nation. People are out of work, business and other closings are hurting our economy, working parents are now challenged with how to

handle "distance learning" for their children, potentially turning a much-needed two-income household into a one-income household. This is not the time for any type of rate increase for any city service; yet, here comes the Staff and Council proposing to put a rate increase burden on the residents and businesses of this city. This is not the time to do this. This is a time for leadership, not resignation.

I urge the council to reject the trash rate increase, toughen up, and task the City Manager and Staff to come up with internal savings that would offset current costs and defer rate increase discussions to a future date when our economy and our community is back on its feet.
