## **ISSUE:**

Review the Criminal Case Book for an Officer Involved Death case for P18-044194 – E. Saldivar.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That the Community Police Review Commission:

1. Discuss any findings or recommendations for the Riverside Police Chief for Criminal Case Book for P18-044194 – E. Saldivar; and
2. Determine, or defer the vote to a future meeting, for the final findings and or recommendations for the Riverside Police Chief for Criminal Case Book for P18-044194 – E. Saldivar.

## **DISCUSSION:**

On July 22, 2020, the Community Police Review Commission (CPRC) unanimously voted to open the review of the Criminal Case Book for an Officer Involved Death, P18-044194 and forward the review of the Criminal Casebook to the August 26, 2020 meeting for further discussion.

On August 26, 2020, the CPRC unanimously voted to move the discussion of the Criminal Casebook for P18-044194 – E. Saldivar to the September 23, 2020 meeting in order for Commissioners to have the opportunity to review the final Independent Investigative Report prepared by consult Mike Bumcrot.

The publicly available redacted case file is not attached to this agenda due to the volume of information.
