SUBJECT: HOUSING AUTHORITY'S AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECTS UPDATE

ISSUE:

BACKGROUND:

At the last Committee meeting, staff was directed to add a standing item on the Housing and Homelessness Committee agenda to provide ongoing updates on Housing Authority's affordable housing projects.

DISCUSSION:

The Housing Authority has 537 housing units in the pipeline for development, which include 229 permanent supportive housing units. An update on these projects are listed in Attachment A.

Housing Authority staff will continue to provide the committee with a monthly update on affordable housing projects in the pipeline for development.
