SUBJECT: COMMISSIONER ANTONIA QUEZADA'S ABSENCE FROM THE COMMISSION ON DISABILITIES MEETING ON JANUARY 16, 2020

ISSUE:

Determine whether Commissioner Antonia Quezada's absence on January 16, 2020, should be recorded as an excused or unexcused absence.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Commission on Disabilities determine if Commissioner Antonia Quezada's absence from their meeting on January 16, 2020, be excused or unexcused.

BACKGROUND:

On July 26, 2016, the City Council approved a recommendation from the Governmental Affairs Committee to amend the Board/Commission Attendance Policy. The policy states, "Board/Commission members shall make every effort to notify the Chairperson or his/her designee no later than 24 hours prior to any regular meeting of his/her intent not to attend said meeting. A member's inability to provide 24 hours advance notice shall not preclude the board/commission from exercising its discretion to excuse said absence as outlined in Section 805 of the City Charter."

DISCUSSION:

Commissioner Quezada was not in attendance at the January 16, 2020 Commission on Disabilities meeting. Staff did not receive advance notification of her absence.
